

# Three pronged approach to effective strategy





#### The Senior Leadership Team

#### **Master Document**

- Entire vision as part of the SDP/ SIP
- Consider strengths of all staff and identified areas technology can reduce workload/ increase efficiency
- Intention for all students (skills acquired for all)
- Pedagogical approaches (basis for effectiveness and measurable progress)
- Back end and front end strategy
- Accessibility and safety for all
- Staff audit and development of skills (including all stakeholders)
- Assessment and review processes
- Fundraising strategy

## Information Technology Facing Strategy should include



Guided direction of digital infrastructure needs and agreed steps to ensure:

- Privacy and security
- Connectivity
- Server stability + longevity
- Procedures for onboarding and leaving staff
- Understanding of front end user requirements (MDM, BYOD, Application restrictions, storage etc)
- Issue reporting procedures
- Simple self-help guidance
- Process for additional software requests




## **Teacher Facing Strategy should include**

- School vision for use of technology
- Access to self audit of skills and confidence
- Access to self directed CPD
- Links to pedagogical approaches of focus for whole school
- Processes for improvement of practice (team teaching/ record-review etc)
- Clear steps for new to site teaching staff
